Champagne that always delivers. Lingering fruit flavours. It's well balanced and pleasantly fresh.

Pale gold with a delicate persistent fizz. Elegant aromas of citrus and almonds with a pure palate.

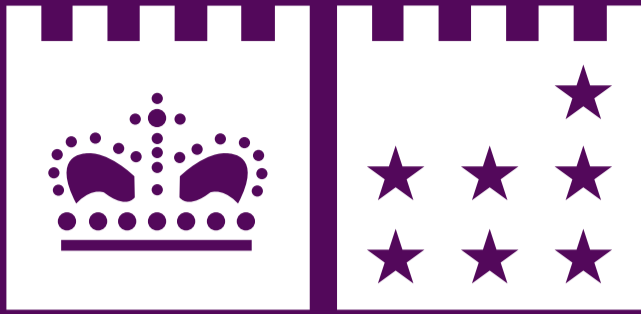
- 24. Merlot, Tierra Alta 2004 (Chile) 14% ABV**
